

“Running For Rich”

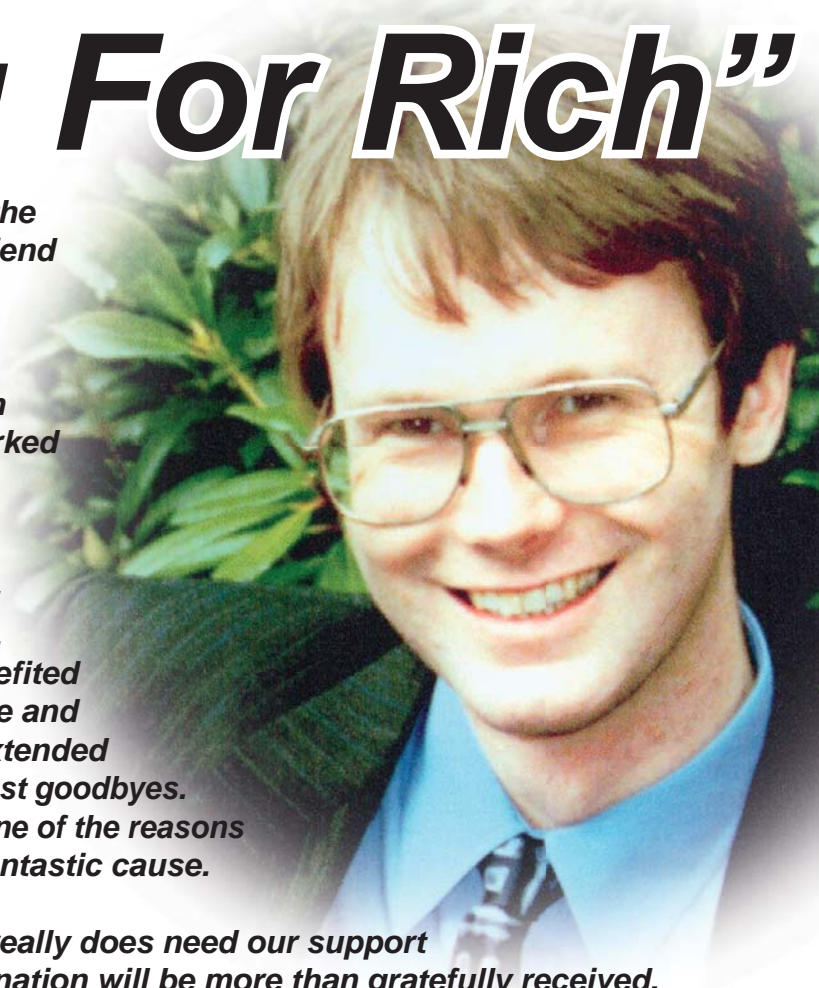
We are helping to raise much needed funds for the Douglas MacMillan Hospice in memory of our friend and colleague, Richard Morris who died there in September 2007.
